

教育部於 2019 年 10 月公布「教育部補助專科以上學校校內學生宿舍提升基本設施及公共空間整體改善作業要點」(以下簡稱宿舍改善要點)，為「新宿舍運動」揭開序幕。新宿舍運動的主要推手為吳思瑤立委，她自 2018 年起就不斷與教育部討論和研究，以擬訂施行目標和措施。2019 年 3 月，吳立委透過總質詢獲得行政院蘇貞昌院長的支持，在政策目標和內容更具體化後，該年 8 月蔡英文總統在參觀逢甲大學學生宿舍時宣布，以 5 年 50 億經費推動第一期新宿舍運動(2019-2023)。臺灣高等教育學府的宿舍居住環境與生活，就此展開歷史新頁，大學校園環境也隨之迎來充滿期許的轉變。

推動新宿舍運動的目的是為了「打造年輕世代宿舍新環境」，同時提升大學宿舍的「質」與「量」，除改善基本居住設施及公共空間品質，融入同儕交流及學習等新機能，成為融合居住和學習的複合空間外，亦有利於激發學生創意並翻轉學習。吳思瑤立委曾以「宿舍不只是宿舍」來闡釋新宿舍運動，認為接軌國際和以學生為主體，是新宿舍運動的兩大主軸。以美國為例，優質宿舍是頂尖大學的必要設施，且宿舍品質已成為大學排名指標之一。如此一來，優質宿舍成為企業的搖籃，才有機會成就馬克·祖克柏在哈佛大學宿舍創辦社交平台 Facebook、麥可·戴爾在德州大學宿舍創立 Dell 電腦公司等創業典範，在歐洲和日本也不乏如此的案例。

相較之下，臺灣各大學宿舍仍自限於滿足生活基本功能，僅追求數量增長，實與國際潮流落差甚大。宿舍改造的出發點也必須以學生為主體來思考，除透過宿舍論壇回應學生需求以完善居住功能外，讓宿舍成為「生活即是學習」的處所，提供優質的公共空間與社交活動必須成為宿舍的根本需求。如吳立委所提，針對宿舍進行如此優渥的補助，在臺灣前所未見，尤其不分公私立學校均可申請補助，回應社會要求平等對待每一位大學生的呼籲。

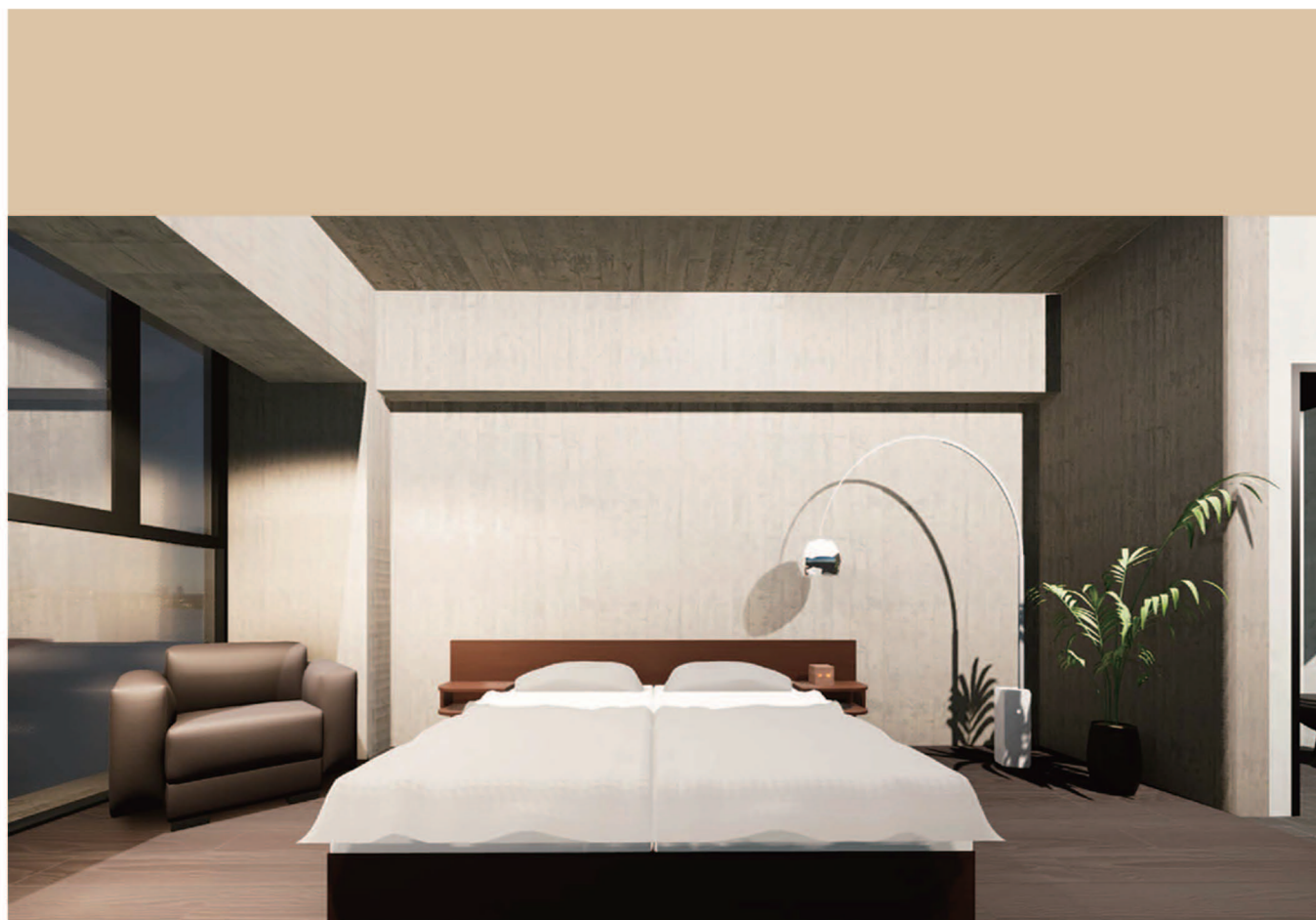

「設計導入提升品質」為新宿舍運動的核心行動之一，目的是從使用者思維切入進行設計，以提升宿舍功能及品質，形塑令人愉悅、願意長時間停留、增進人際交流並激發創意學習的公共空間。為此，在宿舍改善要點公布後，教育部邀請本校建築設計學系六位專兼任教師為核心成員，搭配其他大學建築設計領域的菁英教師，組成「專科以上學校宿舍提升宣導團隊」，輔導有意願加入新宿舍運動的大專校院，重新認識宿舍在校園環境中的積極角色，以學校特色思考宿舍改造的主軸。因此，本次宿舍改造並非以單一標準打造全國均一的宿舍空間，而是鼓勵各校發揮創意，透過重新定義學校特色和發展方向，制訂全校宿舍改造的整體方針。如本校臺北校區第三學生宿舍新建案，獲得 2,860 萬 3,679 元補助，原因之一即是宿舍新空間能與設計學院教學活動相互搭配，不僅凸顯本校既有特色，也使新宿舍產生獨特的魅力。

本校建築設計學系在接受這項「翻轉大學校園」的歷史性任務後，由王俊雄主任擔任宣導團隊計畫主持人，蕭有志、許棕宣及漆志剛三位專任教師分別擔任三組組長，對臺灣本島及離島各大專校院進行宿舍改造輔導，團隊成員也包含陳昱安和褚瑞基兩位兼任教師，以及淡江大學、成功大學、亞洲大學、清華大學等校教師。截至 2022 年 1 月，宣導團隊已成功輔導 16 校 18 案通過嚴格的審查，合計獲補助金額近 10 億元，其中本校北高校區各有一案獲得補助，金額達 7,477 萬元。宣導團隊也於本校舉辦四次大型宣導講習及說明會，全國各大專校院均派高層主管參加，本校謝孟雄董事長和丁斌首校長亦親自出席與會，給予最大的支持。

Dean of General Affairs Chu Hsu-Cheng (朱旭建) talked about the construction of the third student accommodation at an information session on April 10, 2021.

In October 2019, the Ministry of Education announced a new funding program to improve the student accommodation facilities and communal areas for colleges and universities in Taiwan. This announcement ushered in the start of the new student accommodation movement. The main proponent of the movement is Legislator Wu Szu-Yao (吳思瑤), who has been in close discussion with the Ministry of Education on the issue since 2018. In March 2019, Ms Wu secured the support of Premier Su Tseng-Chang (蘇貞昌). When policy goals and details were in place, President Tsai Ing-Wen (蔡英文) announced a NT\$5 billion plan over five years for the first phase of the new student accommodation movement (2019-2023) during a visit to the student dormitory in Feng Chia University. This marks a new chapter of student accommodations in Taiwan's higher education sector and exciting changes on campuses around the country.

The purpose of the movement is to create a new student living and lifestyle experience, while improving the quality and amount of student accommodation in universities. In addition to basic facilities and communal areas, the movement encourages universities to create



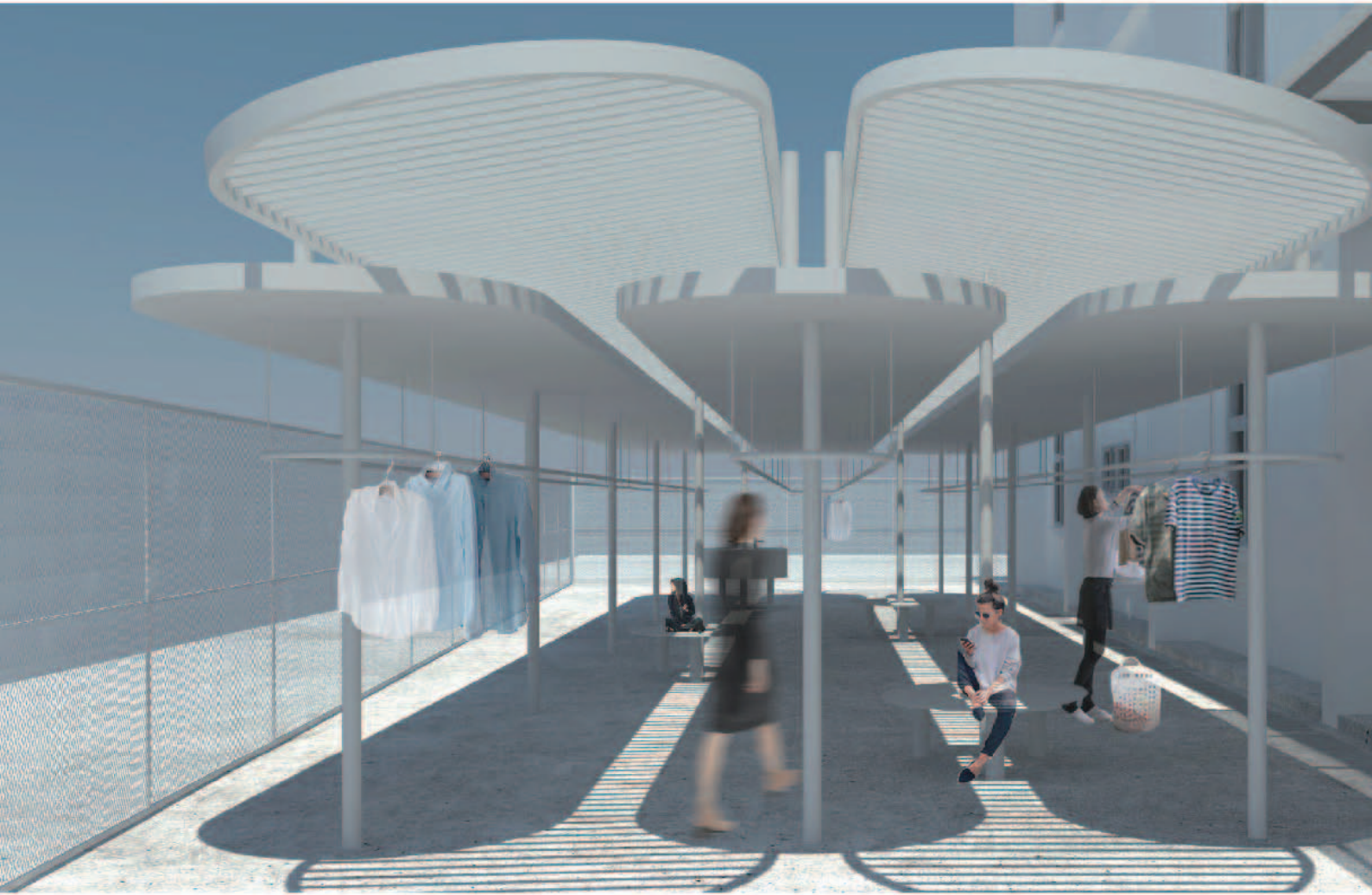

spaces that offer opportunities for students to interact and learn. Student accommodation is no longer just a place for living but a space to learn, a stimulating change that will spark creativity and new ways of learning. When defining the movement, Wu Szu-Yao once pointed out that “a dormitory is not just a dormitory” and the movement aims to create a student-centered space that encourages students to connect to the world. In the U.S. for instance, excellent student accommodation has become essential for top universities and its quality is also a key indicator in university rankings. Good accommodation has also become instrumental in the creation of businesses-- Mark Zuckerberg came up with his social networking platform, Facebook, in a Harvard dorm room and Michael Dell launched Dell Inc. from his dorm room at the University of Texas. Similar stories have been told in Europe and Japan as well.

In comparison, while the amount of student accommodation has been on the increase, most of them offer only the most basic function for residents. The new generation of student accommodation also needs to be student-centered in its design. In addition to responding to students' needs through the accommodation forum, new student accommodation should offer enough communal areas and spaces for student interaction so the residents can continue to learn outside the classroom. As Ms Wu mentioned, it has been unprecedented in Taiwan for the government to provide so much funding for both public and private universities so all students can enjoy the same resources whichever university they go to.

Design is also at the core of the movement. The aim is to design from the perspective of users to improve the functionality and quality of the



facilities and spaces in student accommodation. Moreover, communal areas should be pleasant enough for residents to hang around in for longer amounts of time to interact with other students and encourage creative learning experiences. Therefore, the Ministry of Education invited six of our professors from the Department of Architecture as the core members, with a couple of professors from the same field from other universities, to form an advisory committee. The team supports colleges and universities that are interested in joining the movement, helps them understand the role student accommodation plays on campus and redesigns their student accommodation according to the specific features of their institutions. The goal of the movement is not setting a one-size-fits-all template for student accommodations around the country but to encourage each university to use their creativity to redesign their own student accommodation

according to the features and direction of their institutions. Take Shih Chien University's third student accommodation on the Taipei campus for instance. The project was granted NT\$28,603,679 because the new spaces designed can be used for the teaching and activities of the College of Design. The design showcases our unique feature and adds a touch of charm to the new student accommodation.

When our Department of Architecture was assigned the task of forming an advisory committee, Department Chair Wang Chun-Hsiung (王 俊 雄) became the head of the committee. Assistant Professor Hsiao Yu-Chih (蕭 有 志), Associate Professor Hsu Tsung-Hsuan (許 棕 宣) and Assistant Professor Chi Jr-Gang (漆 志 剛) each serve as the head of a sub-committee to offer advice to colleges and universities in Taiwan. Adjunct professors Chu Ray S. C. (褚 瑞 基) and Chen Yu-An (陳 昱 安), as well as professors from Tamkang University, Cheng Kung University, Asia University and Tsing Hua University, are also on the committee. As of January 2022, the committee has helped 18 projects from 16 universities and colleges pass strict review. Nearly NT\$1 billion of funding in total has been awarded. Both Shih Chien University's Taipei and Kaohsiung campuses have been granted a total of NT\$74,770,000 in funding. The advisory committee has organized four major information sessions. Top management from many colleges and universities, including our Chairman of the Board Shieh Mung-Shiung (謝 孟 雄) and President Ting Pin-Shou (丁 斌 首), attended the events to give their support.

The right to an adequate standard of living is a fundamental human right. As a higher education institution, Shih Chien University believes it is our responsibility to offer a good living environment with adequate spaces for our students. The new student accommodation movement will inject energy into our campus, fundamentally changing the relationship between students and the campus. Moreover, the movement can help improve their learning experience, encourage students to identify with the university, and ensure we stay in sync with global trends. The Department of Architecture is honored to take part in this monumental movement. We will duly play our part and hopefully contribute to higher education in Taiwan.
