融合生活與學習的新世代校園風景： 臺北校區第三學生宿舍規劃

為因應全球高等教育國際化之趨勢，本校訂定各項國際化招生策略，並積極規劃多元的國際化課程與活動，營造相關的學習氛圍及環境，開拓師生國際視野，掌握國際脈動並與國際接軌，以提升學生國際化素養與競爭力。整體成效除具體見於國際生人數的成長外，更於 2017 年獲《Cheers》雜誌評選為「赴海外交換之學生能量 Top 17」及「大學辦學績效 Top 20」；《高教創新月刊》發布「全臺灣歷年參與國際設計競賽獲獎總數排名私立大學第一名」；2018 年《遠見》雜誌「臺灣最佳大學排行榜調查」國際化程度全臺灣第 7 名。為進一步拓展國際交流與招生效益，本校在董事會支持下進行第三宿舍之興建規劃，委由知名的大元建築工場—姚仁喜(Kris Yao)建築大師設計，為地下 1 層地上 10 層的建築，總樓地板面積 6,096.32 平方公尺，可提供 378 個床位，每間房型均有獨立衛浴，未來可提供本國學生、國際生、國際學人等申請入住，以進一步滿足學生住宿需求，宿舍內部空間設計則特別邀請本校設計學院三組校友團隊為學弟妹們規劃，其中亦有傳承之意義。

另一方面，回應教育部自 2019 年 10 月起所推行「新宿舍運動計畫」之構想，期許未來學生宿舍成為交流、學習、創業之核心，在謝孟雄董事長、丁斌首校長帶領下，本校於 2021 年開始，透過跨單位整合，由國際事務處、學生事務處、總務處、設計團隊與師生進行十餘次討論並凝聚共識，融入學習、同儕交流及創意機能等想像。在此構想下，第三宿舍內公共空間規劃占比達 48%，設有自助洗衣空間、影像工作區、多元會議室、自習空間、休憩影音共享區、簡易共享廚房（設置穆斯林專區）、無人商店……等學習與居住的複合空間，使國際生在異鄉求學時仍能感受家鄉固有文化及友善環境。此外，亦在其中規劃了展演活動場域，除凸顯設計特色外，更提供國內外學生交流機會，建構共創共學的生活場域，藉此在校園中撒下學習的種子，以賦予教育的新氣象及更多的可能性。

本案整體規劃因透過校友共同創作，有助於教育理念的傳承與延續，使整體規劃及建築設計成為校園美學的延伸，「新宿舍運動計畫」審查委員認為其校園規劃與建築理念足以作為示範學校，獲教育部核定全額補助所申請 2,860 萬 3,679 元之內裝費用。本校亦將透過此次第三宿舍之興建，於未來帶動既有第一、第二宿舍之整體改善計畫，提升學生宿舍公共空間之質量，使臺北校區的宿舍生活區活化為新世代學生學習空間，讓宿舍不僅止於傳統宿舍，在校地有限的現況下，讓學生的學習由教學區域延伸至住宿區域，使空間之應用多元化，以建立學習與生活無縫接軌的新世代大學校園氣象。

A New Generation of Campus Erasing the Boundary Between Students' Personal Life and Learning: The Third Student Accommodation on the Taipei Campus

In view of internationalization in higher education becoming a trend globally, Shih Chien University has devised strategies to recruit international students and organized international courses and events. The aim is to create a learning environment that is in sync with the global trend and can effectively enhance the competitive edge of its students. In addition to seeing an increase in the number of international students recruited, the university was also selected by Cheers Magazine as one of the top 17 universities with the highest number of overseas exchange students, and one of the top 20 universities with outstanding performance. The university was also selected by Innovation in Higher Education Bi-monthly as the top private university with the highest number of awards in international design competitions. In 2018, in a Global Views Monthly best universities in Taiwan survey, Shih Chien University was ranked 7th in the category of internationalization. As part of the effort

to encourage international exchange and student recruitment, with the support of its board members, Shih Chien University will begin the building of the third student accommodation. Well-known architect Kris Yao (姚仁喜) from ARTECH has been commissioned to design a 11-story building (including one underground story) of 6096.32 m², which can accommodate 378 beds for both local and international students, as well as visiting scholars. All room types come with a private bathroom. Three groups of alumni from the College of Design were invited to design the interior space of the student accommodation.

In October 2019, the Ministry of Education proposed the idea of a new student accommodation movement, with the hope that student accommodation can become a center of exchange, learning and entrepreneurship. Guided by Chairman of the Board Shieh Mung-Shiung (謝孟雄) and President Ting Pin-Shou (丁斌首), Shih Chien University has organized a dozen cross-departmental meetings between different parties, including the Office of International Affairs, Office of Student Affairs, Office of General Affairs and the design team, to explore the possibility of combing the elements of learning, exchange and creativity in the same space. In line with the

discussion, 48 percent of the third student accommodation will be communal areas for laundry, visual and audio workstations, meeting rooms, study spaces, lounges, kitchens (including a dedicated area for Muslims), an unmanned store and so on. The combination of learning and living spaces aims to provide a friendly cultural experience for international students. The accommodation also includes a performance area, a feature of our famous design courses. The performance area offers more opportunities for all students to interact with each other so both local and international students continue to learn outside classrooms.

The entire project, a collaboration of our alumni, demonstrates a continuation of the philosophy of our education. The concept and the building itself serve as an extension of campus aesthetics. The review board of the new student accommodation movement decided the planning and building of the project can become a model for future projects and the project was awarded the entire sum of NT\$28,603,679 by the Ministry of Education. Shih Chien University will also use the building of the third student accommodation as a model for the improvement project for the first and second student accommodations. We plan to improve the quality of the communal areas in

student accommodations on the Taipei campus, which will become an alternative learning space for students in the future. With limited campus space, the project expands the learning opportunity from classrooms to dormitories, making a traditional living space more diversified in its uses and creating a new lifestyle that provides more learning opportunities in students' everyday life.
